## Course Description including any prerequisites or other requirements:

This class will predominantly utilize *Five in a Row Book 1* as the spine for the homeroom class although some supplementation with the *Memoria Press Enrichment Guide for Kindergarten* will occur. The *Five in a Row* program is literature based and provides a beautiful introduction to good, classic literature. The homeroom class consists of story time and the story will open the door to coordinating activities in a range of subjects, such as: math/counting, history, geography and social studies, and language arts. The *Five in a Row* story lessons will coordinate with the liturgical and calendar year when possible and those themes will spill into the other areas of study: science, art and music. The class will partake in simple, fun science experiments to help develop a love and curiosity for God’s creation. Students will be able to explore different art mediums throughout the weeks, so wear appropriate clothes! During Spanish class the students will learn and develop skills related to basic communication and vocabulary acquisition in Spanish. They will participate in a variety of activities practicing, understanding, and speaking Spanish including singing, coloring, playing games, and learning to work with partners. It will be a fun and accepting environment for learning a new language. Kindergarteners will also do calendar work, play outside for recess (weather permitting) and have snack time. Different teachers will rotate into the homeroom class to teach the varying subjects and will be paid separately (see below).
